Response:

To be in tune with the vision and mission of the institution; the principal very frequently held the meetings with the faculty and the non-teaching staff. The management entertained every staff member regardless of his/her designation concerning his/her say about the development of the college. The management took into consideration the suggestions put forth by every staff member and tried seriously to fulfil the same. The management provided adequate infrastructural facilities and other facilities for the smooth operation of the college activities. The management every time encourages the staff and the student for their participation and noteworthy work for the development of the college such as curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular and research activities. The management praised the staff for their achievement in their respective fields. The management provides all kinds of support to fulfil the vision and mission of the institution.

The college is located in rural district. It is also on the border of two regions i.e., Vidarbha and Marathwada. The town Deulgaon Raja comprises in Vidarbha. Since this town is on the boundary of two regions just five kilometres from the Marathwada region which is affiliated with another University i.e. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad which is just 85 K.M. away from Deulgaon Raja. The university to which our college is affiliated i.e. Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University Amravati is 250 K.M. away from Deulgaon Raja. Naturally, some students have their inclination towards the Marathwada region and University due to its proximity. Despite this, we have been trying to augment the quality of our education, courses, curricular and extracurricular activities by giving the students the best out of us.

The mission statement of the college is 'Shabde Watu Dhan Jan Loka' in Marathi which means in English "imparting wealth of knowledge to the students and transforming Students' and Community's lives through education". These Marathi



lines are taken from the book Tukaram's Gatha by the great Marathi poet Sant Tukaram. In compliance with the mission statement of the college, the institution along with its faculty always tries to be honest in providing quality education to the students who seeking admission to the college. Besides, through corporate activities, the institutions try to awaken the liking for education among the people in the periphery of the town. The institution always works according to the needs of the students i.e. the teacher engages in competitive examinations, classes, and career guidance classes also organizes the activities for society and due attention is paid to the academic development as well as personality development of the students. To cater for the needs of higher education of the students in and around Deulgaon Raja the institution started the 'Science' faculty in 2009. The institution also introduced new subjects from 2010 like English and Marathi Literature, and Geography on a self-financial basis. Moreover from 2010 P.G. courses like M.A. English, M.A. Marathi and M.Com. are also started so that girls should not go a long way to complete their higher education. The students' facility centres started for students under the 'Earn and Learn' scheme. Every academic year is always full of various activities where students get opportunities to present themselves in different activities. The N.S.S. and NCC units are always active to organize various co-curricular and extension activities. Study tours, interviews of eminent persons, wall magazines, sports activities, cultural activities, extracurricular activities etc help the students for overall development. The College is always at the forefront in order to practise new changes. In this connection, IQAC conducted a workshop on 'The implementation of the National Education Policy' with the help of all departments in the college.

The college formed fifty-three committees for the internal administration of the college as well as for the decentralization of the work. The college promotes a culture of participative management. The college constitutes committees for general and academic development it includes faculty, non-teaching staff and students' participation. The administration has opted for a decentralized mode for smooth and effective functioning. The Principal welcomes the innovative ideas, concepts and thoughts of the different committee members and involves them in the decision-making process. The governing body is the highest decision-making authority with the Principal as the secretary but the views of all stakeholders are taken into



consideration while executing any important plan. Regular meetings are conducted with IQAC, staff and the management to discuss every issue and activity to be implemented.

As a case study, we would like to give an example of our Admission Process. The Admission Committee in the college forms teams of teachers to visit the nearby villages to counsel the parents and teachers regarding the importance of higher education, available good infrastructure, facilities and courses in the college. When the sessions begin the teachers during the first ten days visit the villages either in the morning or in the evening. About forty-seven villages are visited. The feedback from the villagers is also collected regarding their suggestions if any. There are about 15 teams of teachers. One team is in the college to guide the students regarding the admission process while the other fourteen are visiting the villages. The work of the teams goes on rotationally. It helps us to come across with the parents and the difficulties of the students. As a result, we try to solve their problems if possible and help them to seek admission in our college.



About Sansthan

Deulgaon Raja is a city and a municipal council in Buldana district in the state of Maharashtra, India. Balaji Temple, situated in Deulgaon Raja, Tehasil in Buldhana district is dedicated to Shri Lakshmi Vyankatesha. Shri Balaji from Deulgaon Raja is considered the incarnation of the Tirupati Balaji from the State of Andhra Pradesh. The idol of Shri Vyankatesha along with goddess Lakshmi in the temple is as small as a forefinger and is made of five precious metals. Shri. Rao Jagdeorao, the great-grandson of Raja Lakhujirao Jadhao, the founder of the 'Sindkhedkar Jadhao' dynasty and the father of Rashtramata Jijau, founded the 'Balaji Maharaj Sansthan' in 1692 in Deulgaon Raja. The 'Balaji Sansthan' is a symbol of secularity and has always been active in social services by participating in various religious and social activities. To extend its social contribution the 'Balaji Sansthan' in the year 1967 started Shri Vyankatesh Arts and Commerce College in Deulgaon Raja.

India got freedom in 1947, the period of 1967 had equalled the Medieval Period in terms of higher education (so far as Deulgaon Raja is concerned). The then trustee of 'Shri Balaji Sansthan', Late Raja Rajendrasing Jadhao, realized the importance of higher education, particularly the education of the downtrodden and the people living in rural areas for the development of the state as well as the country. Taking into consideration the acute need of higher education in this area. He started the college to avail the facility of higher education to the people in the periphery of Deulgaon Raja. Presently, Hon. Raja Vijaysing Mansingrao Jadhao is the hereditary trustee of the Sansthan and under his able and valuable guidance, the College is making remarkable progress.



ABOUT COLLEGE

Shri Vyankatesh Arts and Commerce College is established in the year 1967. The college has completed 50 years of excellence in 2017. Due to this, the College celebrated the 'Golden Jubilee Year' in 2017 by taking various programs and events. It is run by Shri Balaji Sansthan, Deulgaon Raja, a charitable trust in Deulgaon Raja. The Chairman of Shri Balaji Sansthan Late Raje Rajendrasingh Jadhao started this college to provide the facility of higher education to the people in Deulgaon Raja and the precinct of Deulgaon Raja. He had started this college in his palace (at his residence), and later on, an ex-servant (peon) of this college Shri Mukundrao Chavan donated his 13 Acres & 7 AAR land for the college and in 1971 the college began to meet in the new building on Jafrabad road. Initially, the college started the Arts and Commerce faculty.

The Science faculty has been introduced since 2009 in the service of the people. Presently since 2005 Hon. Raja Vijaysingh Jadhao has been the chairman of Shri Balaji Sansthan and Shri Vyankatesh College Deulgaon Raja. His valuable guidance and moral support have made this college quite popular amongst the people of Deulgaon Raja. The college has adequate facilities for sports, a Library, Cultural activities and Competitive Examinations. The college has well-qualified staff always willing to develop themselves with different curricular and extracurricular activities. Dr. D.V. Gore has been the principal of this college since July 2021 and he has been looking after the affairs of the college excellently. Besides science, courses like M.A. in English, and Marathi; as well as M. Com. are also started. New subjects like Marathi Literature, English Literature, and Geography are also introduced at the undergraduate level. Skill-based course, i.e. Bachelor of Vocational in Agriculture sponsored by UGC New Delhi affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati has been started in 2018. The college also has a study Center of Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik for distance learning courses like Preparatory courses, B.A., B.Com. and M.A. English and Marathi, M.Sc. Mathematics are the courses available in the college under this study centre.

Recently two students achieved Gold Medal in Political Science and History respectively.

Moreover, a colour coat in wrestling is also a matter of pride for the institution. The govt. of Maharashtra awarded the first prize worth Rs. 100000/-to this college at the district



level for successfully organizing the program '**Jagar Janivancha**,' The college has also achieved a district-level first prize in 2008 on successfully organizing the special N.S.S. Camp introduced by the govt. of Maharashtra. The college also achieved '**Paryavaran Purskar 2017**' of SGBAU Amravati. Four students of N.C.C. achieved colour coats for participating in Republic Day Pared at New Delhi in consecutive years. The college also achieved the award of '**NSS Best Unit 2017**' of SGBAU Amravati, as well as awarded '**NSS Best Program Officer 2017**' to Dr. V. R. Bansile by SGBAU Amravati and also the State Government. The college has an updated staffroom, girls' common room, library and office. The cash prizes declared by Shri Balaji Sansthan, the staff of this college and some of the donors from Deulgaon Raja to the meritorious students are also a matter of pride for the institution. The participation of the N.S.S. and N.C.C. volunteers and cadets in the corporate sector is also noteworthy such as their participation in Balaji Palanquin procession to help the people to have the 'Darshan' of Shri. Balaji Maharaj idol comfortably. Moreover, a band of Lezim of the college boys or the Pawali Pathak of the girls is also an attraction centre at the beginning of the palanquin. The college principal along with the staff participated in this activity wholeheartedly. In this way, the college has been trying to adhere to the aims and objectives of the college by performing in curricular, extracurricular and corporate activities. We look forward to more and more development based on our honest work and persistent efforts.

College Development Committee

As per the Maharashtra Public University Act 2016, the CDC is constituted, which consists of the management as a chairman, four nominated members by the president from the executive council, two educationists, three teachers from the college, one representative of non-teaching staff, IQAC coordinator and Principal as an official member. The Act provides for academic autonomy and excellence, adequate representation through the democratic process, transformation, strengthening and regulating higher education, and matters connected in addition to that or incidental to it.

The college has an active College Development Committee (CDC). It is a statutory committee with a mandate to develop, implement and monitor the management program. It meets two times during an Academic year, evaluates the progress of the college regularly and provides guidance and directives for constant improvement in ensuring higher standards of education in the college. It deals with the compulsory requirement of



continuing administrative and academic development. It supports the decisions of IQAC and teaching and nonteaching staff for their development. This committee acts as the liaison between the college staff and the management. It plays an important role in placing before the management, suggestions and issues related to the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college. It discusses the progress of the college.

The College Development Committee recommends the management creation of the teaching and other posts. All the strategic decisions, having an impact on the growth and success of the institution are deliberated and decided by this committee. It also recommends the decisions decided by the committee to the management. It considers and makes recommendations on the inspection report if any. It also makes recommendations to the management for the improvement of the standard of teaching in the college. It also takes decisions regarding the actions required for the improvement of the college. It determines the programmers of instruction and internal evaluation and discusses the progress of the college. It formulates the proposals for new expenditures which is not provided in the college budget. It discusses regarding intake capacity of various programmes and various other matters related to the internal management of the college.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

In pursuance of UGC (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015 read with Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions. (published in the Gazette of India dated 2nd, May 2016). Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is re-constituted to deal with the complaints relating to Sexual harassment in college. Any woman (employee or student) can approach this committee directly or through the Principal if she has any grievance of harassment of the nature stipulated in the act.

Objective

1. To uphold the commitment of the Institute to provide an environment free of gender-based discrimination.
2. To provide a safe and secure environment in college.
3. To instil positive self-esteem and confidence in the female students to make the right decisions in and for their lives.
4. To spread awareness among the students about the social, legal and constitutional rights of women to prevent exploitation based on gender.
5. To develop a permanent mechanism for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment cases and other acts of gender-based violence at the Institute.
6. To develop a multidisciplinary approach for overall personality development.
7. To assist the ICC in conducting the inquiry if /when there is a complaint.
8. To record the minutes of the regular meetings.
9. To organize several Programmes to enhance the confidence level of girl students for their empowerment in society.

Functions:

- Anti-Ragging Committee Student members assist the institution in implementing rigid anti-ragging measures so that the institution becomes a ragging-free campus.

Lectures of Resource persons are organized to prepare various aspects of such exams throughout the academic year. A special reading room is made available to such students with a computer and internet facility.

The library consists of valuable books from various publishing companies all over India of the Competitive Examination. It is a matter of great pride to state that more than 175 students of this centre have been recruited for various Governmental positions and have been carrying out their responsibilities quite magnificently. The cell has earned the reputation as one of the best cells in and around Buldana District. It is firmly believed that through this cell the awareness of the rural student will be strengthened.

This cell prepares a timetable of the lectures to be conducted after the regular college is over. This lecture continues for two hours every day. Different subjects are taught in these lectures. The lectures of some eminent persons are also held besides the regular lectures. The renowned academies in Maharashtra such as Unique Academy, Pune, Study Circle, Deepstambh Academy in Jalgaon, I Learn Academy, Aurangabad, Bhoge Academy in Aurangabad, Reliable Spardha Pariksha Margdarshan Kendra, Beyond Vision Academy in Nagpur and Pre-IAS coaching academy in SGBAU Amravati are also invited to deliver guest lectures to these students.
