## Measure for the security as well as empowerment of women

The College provides specific facilities for women in terms of —

### a. Safety and Security:

1. There is a separate Internal Compliant Committee for girls and ladies employees.
1. In the college campus CCTVs are available 24x7.
2. There are frequent visits of *Damini Pathak* for girls' safety.
3. A suggestion box is also kept for the complaints or suggestions of the girls. The suggestions box is opened with the help of the local police officials every week.
4. Our college has a compound wall. The compound wall makes the college more beautiful and safe for students.

### b. Counseling:

1. The ICC (Internal Complaint Committee) is established for the grievance redressal of the girls.
2. Counseling programs are also organized for girls.
3. About five to seven activities are regularly organized for the empowerment as well as for the security of the women such as, Lawyer's Guidance, Police Official's Guidance, Medical Guidance.

### C. Common Room :

1. The college constructed a girls' common room with washroom.
2. There is a separate Reading Room for girl students in the Library
3. There is pure drinking water facility of Aqua Guard with a water cooler.
4. There is a Vending Machines for sanitary napkins.

### D. Any other relevant information

### Policy Document

In pursuance of UGC (Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015 read with Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions. (published in the Gazette of India dated 2nd, May 2016). Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is re-constituted to deal with the complaints relating to Sexual harassment in college. Any woman (employee or student) can approach this committee directly or through the Principal if she has any grievance of harassment of the nature stipulated in the act.

#### **Objective**

1. To uphold the commitment of the Institute to provide an environment free of gender-based discrimination.
2. To provide a safe and secure environment in college.
3. To instil positive self-esteem and confidence in the female students to take the right decisions in and for their lives.
4. To spread awareness among the students about the social, legal and constitutional rights of women to prevent exploitation based on gender.
5. To develop a permanent mechanism for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment cases and other acts of gender-based violence at the Institute.
6. To develop a multidisciplinary approach for overall personality development.
7. To assist the ICC in conducting the inquiry if/when there is a complaint.
8. To record the minutes of the regular meetings.
9. To organize several Programs to enhance the confidence level of girl students for their empowerment in society.

### 3) Health Awareness Program

One-Day Health Awareness Program on the occasion of International Youth Day, a guest lecture on Personal Health & AIDS awareness was concluded at Shri Venkatesh College of Arts, Commerce and Science in association with the Internal Grievance Redressal Committee, Women Development Cell and National Service Scheme Department under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava Deulgaon Raja, Rural Hospital was the chief guest on the occasion. Pankaj Khare, Head of ICTC at Deulgaon Raja, Bharat Rathore, Matrubhumi Foundation, Mrs. Poonam Mawle of Buldana, Mrs. Radhika Ingle, Shri. Dhokane was present.

The program was presided over by the principal of the college Dr. Dnyaneshwar Gore. The chief guest Pankaj Khare guided the students about How to keep themselves Fit, Healthy habits & AIDS and the precautions to be taken to stay away from it. Mrs. Poonam Mawle, and Mrs. Radhika Ingle informed everyone present over there about the misconceptions about AIDS and the causes of AIDS. How important is premarital AIDS testing? He proved this. The Principal of the College, Dr. Dnyaneshwar Gore told that the Life is very beautiful, cherish it, keep yourself healthy fit and fine and stay away from life-threatening things. On this occasion, an HIV inspection camp was also organized. The camp was inaugurated by librarian Dr. Umesh Deshmukh. 75 students along with professors of the college; tested positive for HIV in this camp. On this occasion, all the teachers, non-teaching staff and staff of the college, Students were present. Introductory remarks were presented by Dr. Rupali Telgad. ### 4) Rally On 'Gender Equality'

The problem of gender inequality is quite widespread in India despite 74 years of Independence and social reforms. In some states, Gender inequality is adversely affecting women of all ages and so they are not able to live and enjoy their life optimally. Female foeticide, low rate of enrolment of girls in schools and colleges, poor proportion of working women in private and Government-run departments, violence against women statistics, etc. tell a sad state



of women in India. For this reason, in school colleges awareness programs such as rallies, lectures or street plays are organised. To keep this in mind a rally on Gender Equality was organised by the Internal Complaints Committee and Women Development Cell on 26<sup>th</sup> August 2022 in Deulgaon Raja to make people aware of the issues related to social evil. The rally was started from Shri Vyankatesh College and culminated at Market Parisar of Deulgaon Raja. Dr. Mahendra Salve, Dr. R. Y. Mane Dr. Rupali Telgad, Dr. J.D. Dhokale and many students took part in the rally. Students carried banners and placards bearing anti-gender discrimination slogans. The reason behind this rally is to end gender disparities, eliminate violence against women and girls' lives, eliminate early and forced marriage and secure equal participation and opportunities. ## 5) Induction Program

Members were introduced to the female students. She informed all the students about the WDC & ICC, its objectives, the healthy atmosphere, safety, security and how the committee works. She also appealed to them, to tell their problems fearlessly if they will face. Dr. R.L. Telgad informed them about the complaint box, vending machine, reading room and common room. She also mentioned the importance of the 'Anti Sexual Harassment Cell' in the college. Then there was a question-answer session. A very good response from the students was received. At the end of the program Vote of Thanks was given by Sau Manjusha Muley. All objectives were achieved. Near about 120 students were present.



## 6) Pauli Pathak in Shri Balaji Maharaj Palkhi

Every year, on Dasera, the Balaji Maharaj Palanquin Procession /festival takes place in Deulgaon Raja, district, Buldana. The festival is held to honour the Shri Balaji Maharaj deity for his significant contributions to Deulgaon Raja. One of the highlights of the festival is a distinctive ceremony featuring a palanquin procession. The people of Deulgaon Raja and nearby villages worship Shri Balaji Maharaj's idol. On regular days, this Idol is worshipped solemnly inside the Temple, but during the festival, the idol is taken on a procession around the Deulgaon Raja. The festival features many lively activities such as the flag procession, Dhol Pathak procession, Varkari Pathak and many people offering ceremonies. However, the most anticipated event is the procession of the deity in a palanquin. The villagers spread flower mats, spray fragrant water, and then place a palanquin in front of the Temple. On the occasion of Vijaya Dashmi, girl students of Shri Vyankatesh (ICC& WDC) College also participated in 'Pauli Pathak' on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2022. They took out an early morning procession from the SVC campus to Balaji Temple. According to this Pauli, Pathak Procession was started with great enthusiasm. There were 60 girl students in the Pathak. The students, accompanied by their teachers, went around the Deulgaon Raja Streets carrying the taal (pair of clash cymbals) in front of a palanquin on their way to the Balaji Faras. This event was brought into existence to sensitize the young minds with traditional integrity amongst each other. It also boosts girls' confidence to play Pauli among all People.

## 7) **Celebration of Savitribai Phule Birth Anniversary**

On 3rd January 2023, Internal Complaints Committee & Women Development Cell in collaboration with N.S.S. organized the Birth Anniversary of Savitribai Phule. Savitribai Phule was a great social worker and the first Lady Headmistress in India. Dr. Jyoti D. Dhokale addressed the students. He compared the present situation and the then situation. He told the students that in very adverse conditions, Savitribai Phule took the education. She faced many problems while teaching the girls, but despite this, she didn't

give up. Today, the students have every facility, but there is a lack of punctuality, regularity and seriousness about the study. Students should take the motivation from the life of Savitribai Phule. Dr. R.L. Telgad expressed a vote of Thanks. 76 students were present in the program. Apart from this program many students also participated in the Quiz Competition on the topic 'Savitribai Phule' Organised by Mauli Uddeshiy Sevabhavi Institution at Deulgaon Raja. Many students won Book prizes. It was a very good response from students.

### **8) Orientation Program for students**

The 2nd meeting of the INTERNAL COMPLAINT COMMITTEE members and the girl students of the college was organized on 08<sup>th</sup> January 2018 at 11.00 am. to find out whether the girl students have any difficulties while they are on the college campus and ensure a healthy atmosphere on the college campus. The Chairperson of the meeting Hon. Principal of the college Sau. Manjusha Muley madam guided the girl students about the healthy atmosphere provided in the college. She appealed them to tell their problems fearlessly if they have; but they did not have such problems. So, the Chairperson of the Committee Dr. J. D. Dhokale discussed about the common room maintenance and the meeting got over.

### **9) Essay Writing Competition**

The Internal Complaints Committee in collaboration with the Women Development Committee organised an Essay Writing Competition on the occasion of International Women's Day on 08<sup>th</sup> March 2023. The topic of the essay writing competition was -1. Women Empowerment Reality and Pain 2. National- International Contribution of Indian Women 3. #### 10) Report on Poster Making Competition on 'Women Empowerment'





#### 1) Rangoli Competition

The Rangoli Competition was held on the campus of Shri Vyankatesh College on 28th August 2021. The theme of the competition was ‘Gender Equality’ The event was organized on the occasion of the Death anniversary of the founder president of the college Late Rajendrasinghji Jadhav. Hon. MLA Dr. Shashikant Khedekar addressed the students and focused on the need of inculcating the values and heritage of the country among the students. He also focused on the need of the hour in the colleges to develop a brotherhood feeling, at the same time, skills of aesthetics, creativity, and innovation can be developed among the students. Altogether 20 students participated in the competition. All appreciated the participants for their laudable work.





## **2) Induction Program For the girl students of the college**

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act was passed on 23 April 2013 with the view to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at the workplace. In line with this Act, on 10th December 2021, Internal Complaints Committee & Women's Development Cell conducted an Induction program on issues related to sexual harassment. It catered to realization of basic human rights of gender equality and guarantee against any reported cases of sexual harassment within the campus. The 'Internal Complaints Committee' aims to promote a social and psychological environment that will raise awareness about sexual harassment in its various forms. Any cases reported, will be dealt strictly by the Internal Complaint Committee constituted by the Cell.

The aim of this program was to acquaint the newly admitted girl students about purpose of ICC and to ensure them a healthy atmosphere while getting education in the college. The guest of honour was N. G. O. member Sau. Malti Kayande (Former mayor). The program began with the worship of the photos of Shri Sant Gadge Maharaj and Sawitribai Phule and lighting the lamp. Then there was a welcome speech by Dr. Jyoti D. Dhokale, the chairperson of the committee. She also introduced the guest. In her introductory remark, she guided the girl students about the Women Development Cell & ICC, the healthy atmosphere, safety and security for the girl students provided in the college. She also told them about the common room and other facilities such as the Reading room, vending machine, Complaint DropBox and other. She appealed them to tell their problems fearlessly if they have any and not to discontinue their education.

Smt. Maltitai Kayande, an NGO member of the committee also guided the students on various aspects the girl students face in the college as well as in the society. She spoke about the facilities provided in the college for the girls acquiring education in the college. She stated the importance of higher education and insisted the girls to continue their education for the development of their own purpose and the society. The program was carried forward by the Dr. Rupali Telgad, the member of the committee. She started her Presidential address by mentioning the importance of constituting the 'Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell' in the workplace and about inculcating gender sensitivity among youths.

Student, Ku. Priya Zore, the member of the committee anchored the Program. Girls were motivated to ask question. A very good response from the girl students was received. The complaints were asked if they had any; but as they didn't have any complaints the program was over. The program ended with the thanks- giving speech of the Student, Ku. Sakshi Sarnaik.



Sau. Manjusha Mule (Former Chair Person of ICC) was also present. Objectives of the Program were achieved. There were around 156 participants.

### 3) “One Day Workshop on Awareness of “Know Your Rights”

One Day Workshop on Awareness on “**Know Your Rights**” was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021. The chief guest on this occasion was a well-known lawyer in Deulgaon Raja Court, Advocate Archana Tai Ghewande. The Objective of the program was to raise the self-esteem and self-confidence of women. The workshop began with Dr J.D. Dhokale ‘Introductory remark’. She elaborated on the importance of women being aware of their Legal Rights.

Dr. Jyoti Dhokale the Chair Person of the Committee invited the resource person to enlighten the students on the Legal Rights of Women. Honourable Adv. Archana tai Ghewande spoke in detail about the Rights of Women (Constitution of India). She explained the enactment of the Act and also the procedure involved in lodging a complaint to the committee. She told in detail the girl students about various provisions provided by Article 14, sections 12, 18 and 20 related to defence, economic protection and domestic violence. She guided the students in detail about safeguarding the rights of women and a safe environment that is free of sexual harassment Act no. 354 and 509 bailable and non-bailable offences.

Dr. Rupali Telgad in her presidential speech explained the importance of legal awareness and “**Know our Rights**” to all women. Miss. Manjusha Mule, a faculty member of the Committee proposed a Vote of Thanks. There were around 150 participants. Students took the pledge of not quitting education, knowing their rights to raise their voices against injustice. Then the students and Faculty members asked their queries related to women’s Rights in India; valuable information for the same from Advocate Archana Tai Ghewande. Miss. Manjusha Mule, a faculty member of the Committee proposed a Vote of Thanks.

### 4) World Human Right Day

World Human Right Day is observed by the international community every year on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021. So, to raise awareness about rights that all human beings are

entitled to, irrespective of factors such as religion, sex, language, race, colour, or nationality and so Shree Vyankatesh College, Deulgaon Raja students were given awareness on human rights and celebrated international Human Rights Day. A special assembly was organised under the guidance of Adv. Archana Ghevande in which students gave awareness on human rights. Mrs Radhika Ingale also informed the students about the strong connection between hygiene and health and stressed the best hygiene practices to adopt. It was a very insightful talk about women's health and highlighted the medical problems faced by



women, especially during covid-19 and how to combat the same. 123 girl students were present and it was a healthy discussion.

## **6) Report on Birth Anniversary of Savitribai Phule**

Internal Complaints Committee and Women Development Cell celebrated the birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule in the College on Saturday, 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022 at 11.00 am. 




## 6) Poster Presentation Based On the Theme 'Stree Sakti and Netrutv'

### 7) One-Day Online Workshop Based On “Nutrition for Healthy Life”




### 15) One Act Play Based On The theme of Gender Equity


